- Lead on weekend worship team 2 times a month
- Oversee at least 1 Sunday morning each month in the absence of Campus Worship Leader
- Prepare for CR Youth services each week and assist with weekend prep when needed
- Program tracks and import song lyrics in preparation for services
- Play and sing for online church recordings twice a month in place of Campus Worship Leader
- Help facilitate all-campus team nights approximately once a quarter
- Share volunteer care with Campus Worship Leader, specifically Crossroads Youth musicians
- Attend CR Youth Worship meetings
- Attend campus staff huddle and all-staff huddles
