Crossroads Church is looking for a highly organized, team player to join our staff as a Producer. The Producer creates an intentional, focused, and well-ordered environment that enhances the inspirational nature for "The Weekend" experience. The weekend experience depends heavily on the meticulous integration of audio, light and visuals. If you are a big-picture thinker and can visualize real-time perspective for a weekend experience, you may be a perfect candidate for this position.

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Weekend Preparation: Collaborate with worship and production teams to create an overall feel for service, lead all technical and service flow elements for the weekend experience.
- <u>Campus Technical Set Up</u>: Weekly programming of lighting, audio set up, adding in graphics and lyrics for weekend worship set, and managing all campus production equipment.
- Audio Engineering: Mix Front of House audio for all services and other events as needed.
- Rehearsal Coordination: Coordinate all aspects of rehearsal to ensure the elements follow in keeping with the goal of an irresistible worship experience. Work closely with worship leaders and musicians on the details and flow of worship.
- <u>Service Producing:</u> Direct all weekend participants (communicators, announcers and worship team members) toward building an environment and experience that is intentional, focused, and well-ordered.
- <u>Build teams:</u> recruit, schedule, train, deploy, guide, inspire others in using their gifts, talents, and abilities in production ministry.
- <u>Event Production:</u> Responsible for all special events or activities happening at campus, including managing all technical responsibilities for youth nights, camps, etc.
- Attend weekly meetings with engagement.
- Participate in campus activities and projects required by Campus Pastor and Production Director.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Education: High school diploma with prior experience in related production or producing role preferred.
- Qualifications
 - Highly organized, team player with strong interpersonal skills, and strong ability to diagnose and solve problems quickly.
 - Strong ear for live audio engineering, prior field experience mixing live audio and working with professional digital consoles preferred. Base knowledge on digital audio systems preferred but not required. Yamaha, Allen and Heath, or DiGiCo experience is a plus.

- Prior experience using lighting software or lighting consoles such as Vista, LightKey, GrandMA, etc. is a plus.
- o Familiarity with ProPresenter, Planning Center or other administrative tools.
- o Openness to personal learning and growth both spiritually and technically.

Environment

- Work is accomplished primarily indoors in an administrative environment
- Working extra hours should be expected at times throughout the year
