Crossroads Church is looking for a passionate Discipleship Developer to join our staff. The Discipleship Developer will oversee the development, materials, communication, and registration for all Crossroads group environments (Growth Track, CORE, Care). In addition, the Discipleship Developer will assist, as needed, with materials, communication, and registration for outreach and missions related ministries. This is a central role, serving all campuses and helping to create accessibility between Crossroads' attendees and our small group opportunities. A person skilled in organization and execution will thrive in this role.

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Oversee the process for recruitment, development, and care for all Crossroads small group leaders.
- Schedule and execute small group catalog and groups launch.
- Work closely with campus pastors to resource their campus small groups.
- Develop and execute central small group leader training.
- Assist with Crossroads small group curriculum writing as needed.
- Oversee identifying and choosing small group curriculum.
- Oversee the implementation and execution of Starting Point, Connections (two ongoing small group opportunities within our Discipleship Growth Track), Foundations (which includes Alpha) and CORE.
- Assist in leadership over any groups' retreats.
- Coordinate materials, communication, and registration for baptisms, "Yes" moments, mission trips, and central outreach events.
- Other duties as assigned by the Director of Discipleship.

- Education: 4-year bachelor's degree in a church-related discipline or extensive experience in the coordination of small groups is preferred.
