The Communications Coordinator is responsible for assisting the Executive Director of Weekend Services in driving the communications process for all weekend services, social media, and other methods. The primary responsibility for this role is to propel the Crossroads mission through consistent marketing strategies.

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Communicates and coordinates effectively with ministries across the whole church to ensure communication projects achieve their goals and are executed properly
- Transfer information, resource, and assign tasks to the communications team (social media, video, design, digital media, coordinators) with information critical to the weekend
- Take notes in weekend and creative meetings, creates assignments, and distributes to-dos for all aspects of the weekend process
- Collaborates with social media and design teams to create effective promotional plans
- Assesses and reports on the effectiveness of communications strategies
- Identifies and resolves any issues with promotional content in a timely and professional manner
- Ensure all promotional and marketing materials meet the church's brand identity strategy
- Manage video shoot scheduling and other logistics
- Attend all-staff huddles on Tuesdays
- Other duties as assigned by the Executive Director of Weekend Services
