A person who is skilled in Planning Center, ProPresenter and Ableton programming will thrive in this role. If you love pouring creative energy into worship experiences and you carry a heart for seeing people moved to the next step in following Jesus, you may be a great candidate for this position.

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist with the creative process by contributing ideas for service elements during weekly planning meetings and then direct the execution of those elements during the weekend services or worship experiences.
- Recruit, develop and care for worship volunteers at the campus through hosting team nights, auditions and assisting with master classes.
- Lead all aspects of the worship experience including scheduling worship team volunteers, importing information to Planning Center and leading rehearsals.
- Participate in youth retreats and special events as asked by Youth Pastor, Youth Lead, Youth Worship Lead, Worship Lead or Campus Pastor.
- Create tracks using Ableton and assist/teach musicians to run tracks for service.
- Work with the Campus Pastor to monitor the budget accounts used to hiring musicians and purchasing needed equipment.
- Monitor the upkeep on campus instruments and equipment.
- Partner with the Producer to achieve the desired “feel” for the weekend experience.
- Attend campus staff huddle and all-staff huddles.
- Other duties as assigned by Campus Pastor.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Education: 4-year bachelor’s degree in related field or extensive ministry experience
- Requirements
 - Able to work independently while still capable of working well and collaborating within a team.
 - Adaptable, with the ability to work in a fast paced, changing environment.
 - Profess a belief in Christ that is demonstrated by actively living out that faith.
- Environment
 - Work is accomplished primarily indoors in a worship environment.
 - Some travel may be required locally to other campuses
 - Frequent exposure to noise more than 84dB
 - Working extra hours should be expected at times throughout the year
