Key Responsibilities

- o Provide administrative support for all Discipleship initiatives including but not limited to groups, missions as well as local outreach.
- o Prepare discipleship content for serve team coaches and team leads.
- Collaborate with staff and ministry leaders to create cohesive strategies for adult spiritual formation.
- Encourage group participation and spiritual formation through life-giving community environments.
- Support and equip staff in areas related to discipleship and growth track strategy.
- o Provide oversight for new believer follow-up, small group culture, and adult ministry initiatives at the Woodbury Campus.
- Oversee the onboarding, training, and development of small group leaders at the Woodbury campus.

- o Support the execution and experience of Baptism services.
- o Coordinate and provide oversight of adult ministry events.
- o Organize and facilitate leader training events.
- o Coordinate church-wide Give Hope outreach and compassion efforts.
- o Fulfill additional responsibilities as assigned by the Next Steps Director.
